



- Language testing is in place in most member states, mostly B2/C1 level required
- Two competent authorities usually in member states with medical chambers, health care or doctor's registry in almost all countries
- Primary source verification by external providers in some member states but use of external providers seems to increasingly common (not always default solution)
- Copies of documents are considered sufficient in most member states
- Mandatory (knowledge/skills) tests in place in most member states, usually combination of written and oral practical tests, e.g. OSCE
- Costs for recognition are usually covered by applicant
